PLEA AGREEMENT

Now on this 28th day of May, 2020, the State of Kansas appears by Assistant District Attorney Maureen A. Brackett and the defendant appears via video and with counsel, Dionne M. Scherff. The defendant agrees to waive his/her physical appearance in court, agrees to appear via video for this proceeding and agrees that the plea was read to him/her out loud in open court. Parties do hereby confirm that the following terms and conditions are mutually acceptable and shall be recommended to the Court at the time of sentencing of this case and are expressly conditioned on defendant appearing for sentencing as ordered, compliance with bond conditions as ordered prior to sentencing, and no new violations of Federal, State or local law prior to sentencing:

1. Dismiss Count I- Aggravated Domestic Battery (Felony-Level 7)
2. Please guilty Count II- Firearm Possession by Felon (Felony- Level 8)
3. Mid-Box Underlying
4. Probation
5. No additional Shock time
6. DV assessment-follow recommendations
7. No violent contact with the victim
8. Standard costs and fees

The defendant acknowledges and understands that if he/she are not a citizen of the United States, a conviction for criminal offense may result in deportation from the United States, exclusion from admission to the United States, and/or denial of naturalization as a United States citizen.
