ORDER DENYING REQUESTS FOR AFFIDAVIT

The Court has before it the “Requests for Disclosure of an Affidavit or Sworn Testimony” filed by Samantha Boring, Sam Hartle, and Jaiyda Tyler, pursuant to K.S.A. 22-2302. The Court also reviewed the State’s “Motion to Seal Affidavit for Warrant” and the State’s proposed redactions and the Defendant’s “Motion to Seal Affidavit for Warrant”. Having reviewed the Request, Motions to Seal Affidavit, and the Affidavit itself, the Court finds as follows:

The Affidavit shall be sealed as it is necessary to do so to prevent the public disclosure for the following itemized reasons as set forth in K.S.A. 22-2302:

- (4) (A) Jeopardize the physical, mental or emotional safety or well-being of the victim, witness, confidential source, or undercover agent, or cause the destruction of evidence;
- (C) Interfere with any prospective law enforcement action, criminal investigation or prosecution;

Based upon the above and foregoing, the “Requests for Disclosure of an Affidavit or Sworn Testimony” are hereby DENIED.
